RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES: There will be a post entry fee of \$25 per horse/rider entry if entered after February 10th at 6:00 PM. Entry blanks will not be accepted unless signed by the owner/authorized agent, rider and trainer. No numbers will be issued without an open check. Current coggins must be presented to the horse show office for all horses on the grounds. Please note barn affiliation on entry form and check.

SCHOOLING: No schooling on Saturday prior to the show. Sunday 6:30-7:30 and additional schooling breaks listed in schedule.

FEES & REFUNDS: \$20.00 office/awards fee will be charged for every horse & rider combination. \$10 EMT fee per entry. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched or classes being scratched or else the class fee may be charged. A fee of \$15 may be charged for open checks not closed out by the end of the show.

RETURNED CHECKS: A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

DOGS: There will be NO DOGS on the property that are not attached by a leash to a person's hand!!!

ATTIRE: SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED. Riders must be properly attired – no chaps. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

RIBBONS, TROPHIES, and CHAMPIONSHIP: All classes receive a prize and 6 ribbons. All Divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve ribbons using the standard tally system: 10, 7, 5, 3, 2, 1. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and trophy will be awarded and Reserve rosettes.

FOOTING: Indoor Ring: 135 x 250 arena with custom Kiser footing. Outdoor Ring: 100 x 200 sand arena

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be cancelled.

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Spellbound Farm against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of an conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Spellbound Farm is not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft.

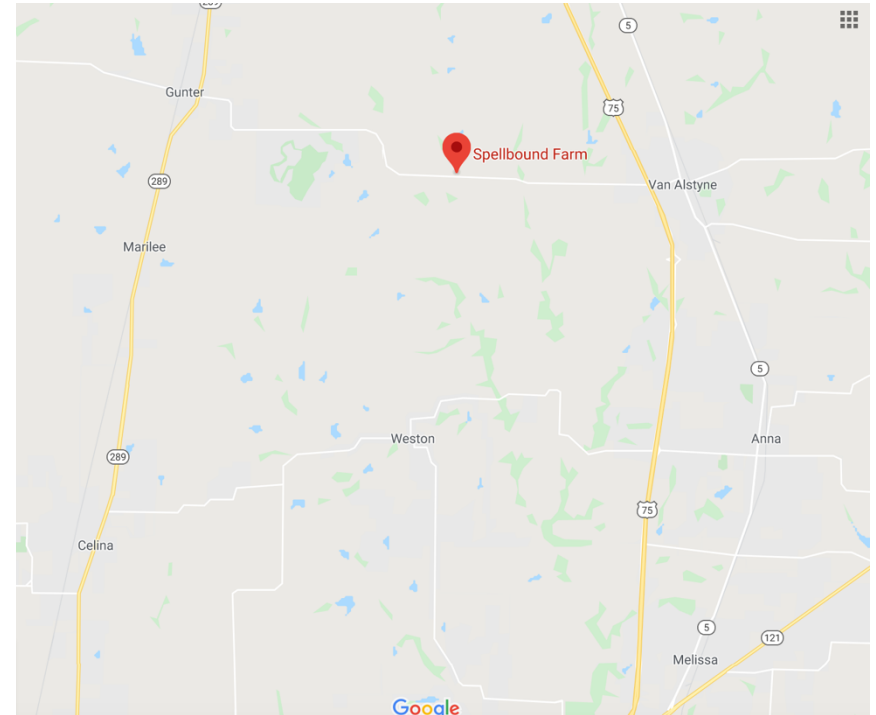
STABLING: Limited stabling available on a first come, first serve basis. Please contact Tracey to reserve stalls: (214) 402-6472

Cross Entries: Horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference

Split Classes: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split

Spellbound Farm Covid-19 Protocol

1. **Show Office** - Only the trainer can enter the show office. Trainers will collect checks and release forms from their clients, and they will bring them to the office and each barn will receive a packet with rider numbers, copies of courses, and schedules for clients. Trainers will also be responsible for closing client checks at the end of the show.
2. **Masks** – To comply with state regulations, masks will be required at all times while on property unless mounted on a horse
3. **Spectators – limit of one spectator per rider**, trainers are responsible for ensuring clients comply to this rule. Management reserves the right to ask people to leave if not in compliance with the 1 spectator per rider rule.
4. **Covid-19 Release Form** – This form must be signed by everyone entering the property (trainers, riders, spectators, etc.) Please print, sign, and scan and send prior to the show or bring signed releases to the show office. Numbers will not be released without a signed release form.
5. **Entries** – The show may be restricted in the number of entries, so please send your entries in. To expedite check-in process, please scan and include coggins and signed releases. **No numbers will be released without check/payment, current coggins and signed releases.**
6. **Parking** –Please keep all your tents, set-ups, cars, etc. in the parking area. **No spectator set-ups will be allowed at the arena.**
7. **Gate Protocol** – we will give each barn a schedule of their approximate rider times in order to keep the gate area clear.
8. **Gate Keeper/Ribbons** – we will have a ribbon station for collecting your ribbons with the results posted. Please maintain your distance when asking questions at the gate.
9. **Social Distancing** – Please maintain your social distancing throughout the horse show. Masks are recommended when you are not showing and for spectators
